

Flights from Southend Airport to France cancelled



TWO flights between Southend Airport and France have been cancelled today.

TWO flights between [Southend Airport](#) and France have been cancelled today.

Flybe has cancelled its 11.10am flight from Southend to Rennes due to a strike by French air traffic controllers.

The 2.45pm flight from Rennes to Southend Airport has also been cancelled.

The strike may continue tomorrow. Details of flights affected on Thursday April 9 have not yet been released.

Flybe said in a statement: "Flybe has been advised along with all other airlines which operate flights to France, that the country's Air Traffic Controllers (ATC) will take part in a two-day strike on Wednesday 8 and potentially Thursday 9 April, 2015.

"As a result Flybe along with other airlines has been asked to plan a mandatory reduction in flights.

"Customers are therefore advised to monitor our live flight departure and arrivals page for the latest information but otherwise to continue checking in as normal.

"Flybe will, as always, do everything possible to minimise any disruption resulting from this industrial action and would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be experienced through these circumstances that are entirely beyond our control."
