

# Fourteen flights diverted from London to Southend airport

Fourteen flights have been diverted from London to [Southend Airport](#) this morning.

All 14 planes were due to land at City of London Airport, but a hole was discovered on the runway, meaning that a host of flights have been diverted.

More could still be diverted to Southend, while train passengers on Greater Anglia this morning complained of a busier-than-usual line.

The airport has posted on its website: "Due to unexpected essential runway maintenance we are currently experiencing delays and cancellations. We are expecting to resume flights by midday.
